

Time Lapse Chart:

When using the Scouting Assistant Time Lapse Software we recommend using 15fps or 15 pictures per second to create your time lapse video.

If you are using the 3G GO-CAM we recommend the image size to be set to 8MP.

If you are using the X-TRAIL-CAM, or UOVISION time lapse cameras we recommend using 12MP/8MP or 5MP.

Number of Images to create a time lapse video:

30 second video	450 pictures
One minute video	900 pictures.
Two minute video	1800 pictures.
Three minute video	2700 pictures.
Four minute video	3600 pictures.
Five minute video	4500 pictures.

Number of Images per hour:

1 picture every 30 seconds =	120 pictures per hour.	Should not use a 3G Camera.
1 picture every 1 minute =	60 pictures per hour.	Should not use a 3G Camera.
1 picture every 2 minutes =	30 pictures per hour.	Should not use a 3G Camera.
1 picture every 5 minutes =	12 pictures per hour.	Should not use a 3G Camera.
1 picture every 10 minutes =	6 pictures per hour.	
1 picture every 15 minutes =	4 pictures per hour.	
1 picture every 20 minutes =	3 pictures per hour.	
1 picture every 30 minutes =	2 pictures per hour.	
1 picture every 60 minutes =	1 pictures per hour.	

When creating time lapse videos it is important that the camera be mounted firmly and unable to move even when checking the system. Using a security box with swivel bracket will solve this problem.

If you wish to change the location of the camera this should only be done in between the programmed event times.

We have found it best to relocate the camera in the morning before the cameras event is due to start. By doing this it will ensure that you have a clean start when editing your pictures. Always recharge your battery and format the SD card before using the system.
